SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS

Meeting last Monday (16th.)

- We welcomed Lorrina (L'Amour's Mum) onto Council to fill the vacancy left at the most recent elections.
- Simon Mossman, media consultant, gave us a presentation about how we might promote the School more effectively and the different levels of support he could offer to assist us. We are meeting again next Monday (23rd.) after School to decide on how we will move forward on this. There is a cost to each level of Simon's support.
- A proposal that we might become a dedicated Montessori School was discussed and it was decided that we might consider running a parallel Montessori stream, but had no wish to totally change the School's operation in this direction.
- It was noted that Le Page is currently over-staffed and that enrolments into 2017 will need to increase substantially to sustain even two teachers.
